Interested in Cowboy Action Shooting?? Then let's get started !!

It is recommended that you attend a monthly cowboy action match or two to get a good feel for exactly what is involved – all you need for a visit is eye and ear protection. There are currently 12 active cowboy action shooting clubs in NC – see the Carolina Cowboy web site for an up to date list. ONSP is one of those clubs and shoots the first Sat. of each month at the Rowan County Wildlife Assoc. range. Feel free to drop by and visit any ONSP monthly match. Let us know you are interested and we will get you assigned to one of the posses at a match so you can observe all of the typical match processes. In addition, if you are interested in shooting a stage, just let us know (see Tracker Mike, Layden Payde or KTown) – we can usually arrange it at either a match or on match setup on Friday afternoon. Don't be shy about asking questions – there are lots of cowboy/cowgirls that are more than happy to explain what is happening.

ONSP has a Friday afternoon (usually 3 to 5 time frame) match setup before the monthly match. We are more than happy to have potential new shooters come by and shoot some cowboy guns – just let us know in advance you would like to do so.
